## COVID-19 Vaccination Vendor Declaration Form

In accordance with EHA's COVID-19 Vaccination Policy, beginning January 4, 2022, vendors covered under the policy are responsible for ensuring their representatives, including employees and subcontractors, comply with this policy, including assuming responsibility for vaccination verification and accommodation requirements for their employees.

The Vaccination Policy applies to the following vendors/contracts:

- If vendor representative or any employee of vendor or subcontractor will spend a total of 8 or more hours within a 30-day consecutive period working **indoors** within EHA buildings or units
- If vendor or any employee or subcontractor of vendor will be completing inspections in units owned or assisted by EHA (including units on the Housing Choice Voucher program)

Vendors with any employees or subcontractors covered under this policy must provide a copy of this fully signed COVID-19 Vaccination Requirement Declaration for Vendors to their designated contact at EHA before they or any subcontractors can begin any work that is covered by the policy.

Vendors found to have provided false documentation will be subject to immediate termination of work and their contract.

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Vendor Declaration:

1. I agree that any of my employees or my subcontractors' employees who meet the requirements above for spending time inside EHA units or buildings have met the requirement for COVID-19 vaccination included within EHA's policy.
2. Any employee or subcontractor who is not fully vaccinated, as defined by the CDC, and is not otherwise exempt from the vaccine requirement, will be prohibited from providing on-site services covered under this policy to EHA beginning January 4, 2022.
